The parchments

From the Archivum Arcis, Armarium D208-209-210-217

6 meters of parchments record the trial acts, the auditions and confessions of the war monks: the key point of a complex episode, set within a thorny international intrigue, where politics and religion were intermingled, as well as money and faith. From the "Archivium Arcis" (or Arcis Archive), Amarium 217, the Chinon paper which sheds new light on the much debated Trial against the Knights Templar.

Pope Clemens V private dossier, from the Avignon record 48

Clemens V private agenda was erroneously bound along with the the Avignon record 48 named to Pope Benedict XII (1334-1342): indeed, it accounts for the finds of the Poitiers papal enquiry and shows what the actual Clemens V viewpoint was with regard to the Knights Templar, thanks also to the countless margin notes, handwritten by the Pope himself, upon his sojourn at Malaucenne abbey, in 1311.

The Seals

of the inquiring Cardinals


With regard to their richest and meaningful iconography, the red wax seals of the investigating cardinals Berenger Frédol, Pietro colonna, Pierre de la Chapelle do match their original counterparts. The seals are manufactured with respect to the ancient tradition, through moulds kept at the Vatican Secret Archive, and undergo a calibrated sequence of handcrafts as well as a complex and delicate polishing action, which actually has each individual seal look 700 years older.

The Volume

The First critical edition of the Knights Templar Trial from original papers

The volume comes in 29X45 cm size and is accomplished in compliance with the Art Edition standards. It contains rare drawings as well as three scores etched by Pietro Marchetti in 1840. Texts are printed in specially-manufactured cotton paper. Golden inscriptions are inserted on the front and back of an elegant goat-leather parchment binding.

A foreword note is personally addressed by Monsignor Sergio Pagano, the Vatican Secret Archive High Officer (Prefect). An historic note comes from Barbara Frale, Vatican Secret Archive Official. Document critical transcript by Marco Maiorino and Pierpaolo Piergentili, Vatican Secret Archive Officials.


A Timeless value

The materials are selected with regard to their durability, and range from a goat-leather treated parchment to a natural pieno fiore Tuscan leather, and on to the specially-handmade cotton paper as well as the dark-gold engravings. These materials are all old-fashioned and traditionally crafted, so that they take on fascinating colours and nuances as time goes by.

Inside the volume are the three magnificent and unpublished etchings dedicated to the Knights Templar: these have been carefully kept at the Vatican Apostolic Library until the present day, and are printed on specially-grained paper endorsed by the Vatican Secret Archive.

The grand documents, i.e., original parchments faithfully replicated and hand-sewn, show in their solemnity an unmatched appeal.

The special case, wherein both the parchment papers and the seals are located, finished to the smallest details, records the number and run of this outstanding "Exemplaria Praetiosa" article.



the ABSOLUTION of the KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

The Chinon paper sheds new historic light on the Trial against the Knights Templar

The Vatican Secret Archive has issued the original facsimile copies of the exclusive and previously unavailable hearing of the acts of the Poitiers Trial against the Knights Templar (June 28 through August 20, 1308). These acts are backed with an extraordinary transcription and a previously unpublished critical edition.

The ancient parchments, and among them the Chinon paper which includes the papal acquittal upon the accusations against the Knights Templar, the private agenda with notes likely written by pope Clemens V. The surviving acts of the pontiff inquiry, kept at the Vatican Secret Archive, show to what extent the pope himself aimed to save and preserve the existence of the Templar Order, assigning it a new role upon restoration of its habits and rules.

A thorough scientific investigation, which harbors the historic truth, and sheds light across seven centuries of inaccuracies and conjectures upon the fate of the "Poor Christ Knight Order".
